

ABOUT THE LEAGUE

The Vermont League of Cities and Towns (VLCT) is a non-profit, non-partisan association founded in 1967 to serve the needs and interests of Vermont's municipalities.

VLCT's regular and associate membership, available to local government, has nearly 400 members. They include all 246 of Vermont's cities and towns as well as numerous villages, housing authorities, county courts, and fire, water, recreation, and solid waste districts.

More than 6,000 elected and appointed municipal officials look to VLCT for legislative advocacy, educational programs, risk management services, and resource sharing. VLCT also works with state agencies, Vermont's congressional delegation, and the National League of Cities to advance municipal interests at the state and federal levels.
