Offers launched in 2020 for
Energy Burden Towns

Efficiency Vermont provided \$25,427 in
rebates for 6 towns (Barre City,
Barton/Orleans, Island
Brighton/East Brighton, Johnson).

Towns will save a **combined \$167,787** over
the lifetime of the projects

1, 5 projects completed so far, with 3 more
in way.

Projects included lighting upgrades, heat pumps
and installing other efficient products in
municipal buildings



On April 14, 2022, Public Policy & Advocacy Director Karen Horn testified before the Senate Natural Resources & Energy Committee regarding H.518, which would target resources to auditing municipal buildings and expanding the State Energy Management Program on energy efficiency improvements.
