Targeted Violence Prevention:

Grievance and Mass Violence

Mass violence is a major public health issue in the United States. Targets include schools, entertainment venues, public spaces, and workplaces. Victims range from students, teachers, concertgoers, and bar patrons to government employees. Although it may initially seem spontaneous and random, mass violence is purposeful, planned, and predatory. Most attackers plan mass violence for days, weeks, months, or even years, and they follow a discernible trajectory toward violence called the Pathway to Violence. This presentation will summarize the steps on the Pathway and focus on the first step, grievance, to explain why attackers "step foot" on the pathway and ultimately commit mass violence.

EXPORT TRAINING can be requested by agencies and departments around the nation. If requested and approved, the training can be coordinated through the FLETC State, Local and Tribal Division (SLTD) and assigned Regional Coordinators.

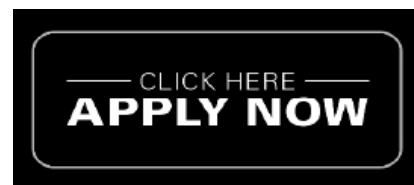
