As Tropical Storm Debby works its way up the East Coast, the Town of Wolcott is monitoring its projected path. At this time there is a potential for 2-4 inches of rain from Friday through Saturday. This could result in localized flooding and damage to roadways.

We encourage people to prepare ahead of the storm, and have a plan if they need to leave their homes for a period of time. The Town of Wolcott will update any emergency flood information on the Town of Wolcott website (<http://wolcottvt.org>) as well as Front Porch Forum.

In the event we need to open an emergency shelter, our location is the Wolcott Town Office on School Street. Remember, DO NOT travel across roadways which are flooded.

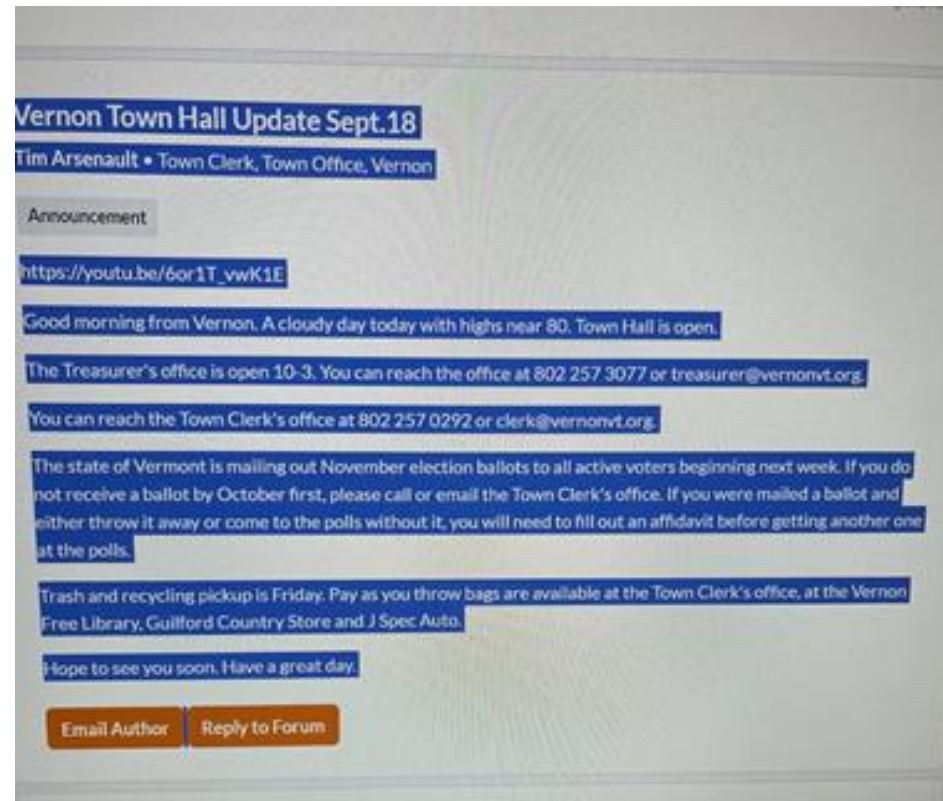
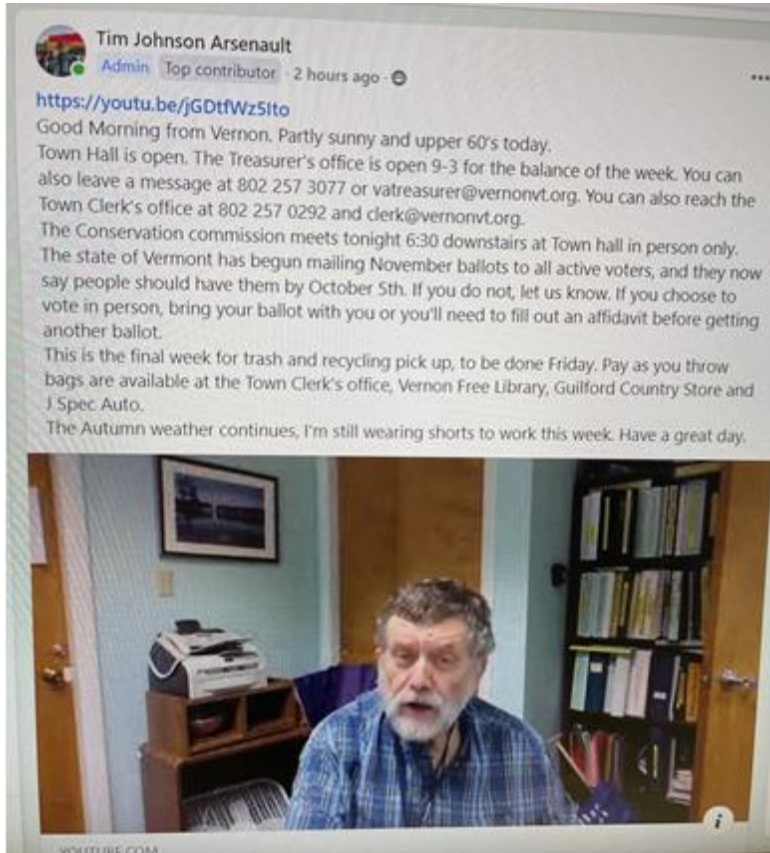
Town Hall News September 26



Good morning from Vernon. Expect rain today with highs in the middle 60's. Town Hall is open. The Treasurer's office will be open between 9 and 3. You can leave a message at 802 257 3077 or vatreasurer@vernonvt.org. You can also contact the Town Clerk at 802 257 0292 and clerk@vernonvt.org. Tomorrow is the final day for Town Wide Trash and Recycling pick up. Pay as you throw bags are available at the Town Clerk's office, Vernon Free Library, Guilford Country Store and J Spec Auto. Beginning October first, residents will need to contract with a private hauler or take their trash recycles and compost to the Windham Solid Waste District transfer station in Brattleboro. The state is mailing November ballots to all active voters. If you do not receive a ballot by October 5th, please contact the Town Clerk's office. If you get a ballot but wish to vote in person on November 5th, bring the ballot with you or you will need to sign an affidavit before getting another ballot. We want everyone to vote, but only one vote per person. Remember, Town offices are closed Fridays but we are available for emergencies. Have a great day and a relaxing weekend.
